The applicant has requested that ECUA provide the service shown above, and has paid to ECUA (or will pay, prior to connection) the initial capacity impact fee or fees shown.

Payment of this initial capacity impact fee or fees entitles the Applicant and future owners or occupants of the property served to utilize ECUA system capacity in amounts not exceeding the Equivalent Average Daily Flow shown above.

If average daily flow (including consumption of water or discharge of wastewater, as determined from average metered water consumption for any period of 12 consecutive months) should exceed Equivalent Average Daily Flow by 100 gallons or more the Applicant or the then owner or occupant of the property served shall pay to ECUA an additional capacity impact fee or fees, based on the amount by which average daily flow exceeds Equivalent Average Daily Flow, and the schedule of capacity impact fees in effect at the time of payment. Upon payment, the Equivalent Average Daily Flow to which the Applicant or other owner or occupant of the property is entitled shall be increased accordingly.

In the event of further increase in average daily flow the Applicant or the then owner or occupant of the property served shall pay an additional capacity impact or fees in accordance with the preceding paragraph.

Irrigation systems connected to the potable meter will result in a monthly wastewater charge for irrigation usage and could significantly increase the contracted gallons per day usage, resulting in an increase of water and/or wastewater impact fees.

Payment of such additional capacity impact fee or fees shall be made within thirty (30) days of notice from ECUA that payment is required, and failure to make payment within the time required shall be a basis for denial or termination of service.

In the event that Applicant intends to no longer own or occupy the property served by this agreement, the Applicant shall present a copy of this agreement to each intended or prospective owner or occupant of the property or any portion prior to such transfer, have that individual/entity acknowledge receipt of a copy of this agreement in writing and provide a copy of that documentation to ECUA prior to the transfer of such ownership or occupancy. If Applicant fails to comply with the provisions of this paragraph, then until such documentation is provided to ECUA, Applicant shall be jointly or severally liable with the owner occupant for the payment of any additional capacity impact fee or fees which may be due.

No capacity impact fee or fees or any part thereof shall be refunded on account of any reduction in average daily flow.
